Scope of Work

The Senior Supply Chain Manager handles the day to day operations related to distribution (incl. transportation) for Santhera's commercial and early access products in Europe, US and ROW, artwork for printed packaging material and serialization, interacting closely with a broad set of functions.

The role reports to the Head Supply Chain, working in close collaboration with multiple functions, technical development operations, quality management, regulatory affairs, pharmacovigilance, finance & accounting, as well as with logistics services providers.

The core responsibilities are:

- Manage and maintain the distribution network for commercial products, ensure supply to patients
- Support on early and expanded access programs for pre-commercial supply
- Transport management for inbound and outbound deliveries
- Master data management for materials
- Setup, modification, filing and control of artwork for printed packaging material
- Process owner for serialization of commercial products and maintenance of relevant system to ensure local compliance
